Proverbs 30:21-22a (NLT)

²¹ There are three things that make the earth tremble— no, four it cannot endure:

²² a slave who becomes a king...

SLAVE/PAUPER-Someone born into insignificance without seemingly any value or options. Defined by "lack." Can become a mindset by which you see everything.

"What I am realizing about many of us is that we spend much of our lives reacting to what we don't want to be instead of responding to the call of God on our lives. We waste a lot of energy trying not to be something. In order not to be something, I have to keep it in front of me so I can avoid it. The crazy thing is that I reproduce what I imagine. If I see what I don't want to be, just envisioning it causes me to reproduce it...We break out of this prison by responding to the call of God on our lives and meditating on His vision for us."
